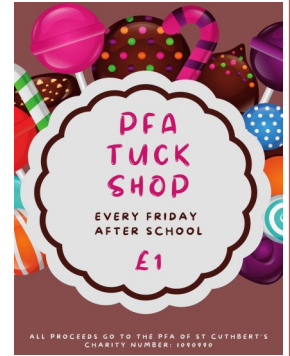
The Explorers are visiting the cinema next Thursday and are equally excited.
