Cuthbert Bears Baby and Toddler Group runs every Thursday in term time, 9.30am-11.15am, in the Maryholme Centre. £2 per family.

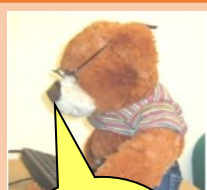
