Years 3,4,5 & 6 had a marvelous day at the Westmorland County show on Thursday. The rain did not stop our fun.

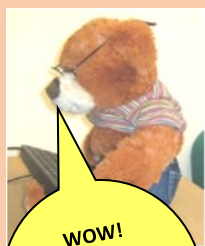
